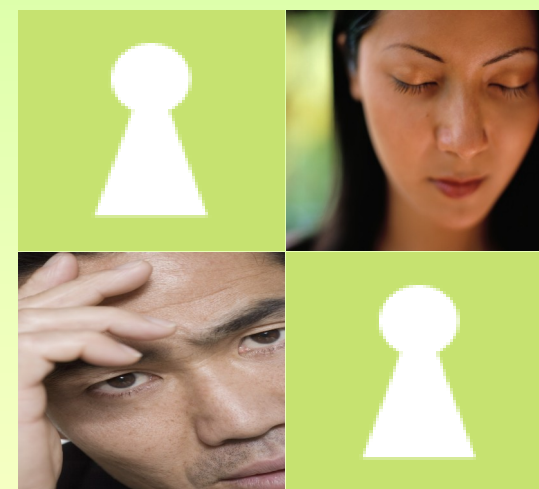

Who Can We Help?

If you are experiencing domestic violence and live within Newark and Sherwood or Bassetlaw District, there is support available which may assist you to feel safe and remain in your home.

The Sanctuary Scheme is a project aimed to make it possible for people effected by domestic violence to remain in their own home if they choose to do so.

The Sanctuary Scheme is free of charge.

The Sanctuary Scheme provides additional security measures to a property such as locks on windows and doors, personal attack alarms, fire safety equipment and anti arson letterboxes.

The Scheme is jointly operated by members from many statutory and voluntary organisations.

The Scheme can help any person who is threatened with homelessness due to domestic violence, regardless of who owns your home.

The Sanctuary Scheme is not appropriate if the violent partner still lives within the accommodation, however you can be supported to access legal advice and take legal action to remove the violent partner from the home and transfer the tenancy into a sole name. Once the perpetrator no longer lives in the property Sanctuary security measures can be installed.
