Supported Housing

The Supported Housing team at Newark and Sherwood Homes are committed to enabling tenants to live independently for as long as possible.



The services offered by the team include:

Community Centre Surgeries

Surgeries are held regularly and offer an opportunity for personal contact with staff to discuss any issues that may be worrying you, get help with filling in forms or offer suggestions for the continuous improvement of the Supported Housing Service.

Support Planning

A plan is compiled with you to assess your needs and any risks involved with living in your home. With your agreement we will make referrals to other agencies for help or advice such as Pension Services, Meals on Wheels etc. The plan will be reviewed annually or following a change in circumstances.

Hospital discharge visits

With your agreement we will visit you following any discharge from a stay in hospital to review your support plan and assess any changes in needs or risks plus making any necessary referrals.

Lifeline

A lifeline is an extension to the cover provided by the emergency alarm service available to all tenants of supported housing, that can include extras such as fall detectors, smoke detectors etc

Datalink

Datalink is a service that gives you a small plastic pot, to put inside your fridge. This pot will hold all your personal information that may be needed in an emergency. A green cross is placed on your fridge door and on the inside of your front door, and this is recognised by all the emergency services.

It can speed up the contact with your family/friends and give doctors immediate information on any medication you may be taking.
